A petition signed by Harley Armstrong and 16 others asking for location and establishment of a certain proposed road described as follows: Begin at center of sec. 18-12-19 th N 1765 ft. th N 87° E 328 ft. th N 10° 10' W 376 ft. th N 1° 37' W 684 ft. th N 18° 27' E 681 ft. th N 28° 15' E 334 ft. th N 80° E 122 ft. th N 39° 45' E 736 ft. th N 11° W 205 ft. th N 12° 37' W 198 ft. th N 14° 42' W 134 ft. th N 1° W 428 ft. to N line of B. Armstrong's place. th N along the most practical route for a road to intersect what is known as the river road. Also, Beg. at center of sec. 7-12-19 th E to intersect the above road. Whereupon the Board of County Commissioners decided to act as viewers to meet in conjunction with Co. Surveyor on July 11-1904 at place of beginning.
