Claims Allowed.

Resolution.

At a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, held on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1904, there being present A. J. Parnell, Geo. Brune and also J. J. Cox, agent and representative of the Missouri Valley Bridge and Iron Works of Leavenworth, Kansas, among other proceedings a settlement was had and made between the said Board of County Commissioners for Douglas County and the said J. J. Cox, on behalf of the Missouri Valley Bridge and Iron Works, at Leavenworth, Kansas.

And, after examining the contracts for the construction of the One-hundred-and-thirty-eight (138) feet steel span being the North span of the Kansas River bridge at Lawrence, Kansas, and the contract for the construction of the <sup>bridge</sup> ~~east span~~ across the Wakarusa River at Eudora, Kansas, as a careful examination of the accounts for the extra work in connection with the fill and construction of side-walk. it is found that there is due from Douglas County to the said Missouri Valley Bridge and Iron Works of Leavenworth, Kansas, the following amounts:

Under contract for the construction of said span across the Kansas River at Lawrence, Kansas, <sup>bridge</sup> \$2760.00

For the construction of said <sup>bridge</sup> across the Wakarusa River at Eudora, Kansas, 1900.00

For extra work and material furnished in the construction of said span across the Kansas River at Lawrence, Kansas and extra work
