We the undersigned petitioners and Tax payers of Douglas County Kansas Respectfully request that there be located, Established and Constructed a levee across the public highway near the lake west bank of the lake where said highway crosses the lake between the North bank one half (1/2) and the S. one half (1/2) of Section Ten (10) in Township Twelve (12) Range Nineteen (19)

That said levee be Constructed not to Exceed four (4) feet high with a base subject to the approval of the said Commissioners said Levee to be Constructed and road maintained at said point by your petitioners, with out any Expense to the County Township or Road District all of which is respectfully requested,
