

Contract with Jasper Rose for
Henry Collins Ditch.
Contract.

Contract entered into, this 8th day of Oct. 1904 by
and between A. J. Parnell, Gus Brune and J. C. Maloney
County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas
on behalf of said county, party of the first part
and Jasper Rose, party of the second part.

Witnesseth, That for and in consideration
hereinafter mentioned party of the second part
hereby agrees to dig, excavate and construct
one certain open ditch and do the necessary
tunnelling in connection therewith, and the
necessary back filling after the tile is in place,
this day ordered on petition of Henry Collins
and party five (5) others. Said work to be done
and performed under the supervision of the
County Surveyor and according to the plans and
specifications now on file in the County
Clerk's office.

It is specially agreed that the bottom
of said ditch shall be four (4) feet in width
throughout its course, with a slope at the side
of one and one-half ($1\frac{1}{2}$) to One (1), the grade to be
given by the County Surveyor.

It is further agreed that party of the
second part shall furnish on the ground all
rock of the proper quality needed in the
construction of water gates for 5⁰⁰ per cord.
It is further agreed that said ditch shall be
wholly completed on or before the 10th day of
Nov. 1904.

In consideration of the same it is agreed
that said party of the second part shall be
paid One hundred and twenty (\$120⁰⁰) Dollars upon
the completion and acceptance of the work by
party of the first part.

In witness whereof the parties have this 8th day
of Oct. 1904 executed the foregoing contract.
