W. A. Pardee Road Case

On presentation of a petition signed by W. A. Pardee & 26 others praying for the location of a road described as follows -

Beginning at the N.E. cor of Sec. 19-14-20 - 26 E. one mile on section line between sections 20 & 27 - or as near as practicable, thence to be 33 ft wide

Whereupon the Board decided to view same, and fixed date of December - 21st for date of view - when they would meet, in conjunction with the Co. Surveyor at the place of beginning

August Borble Road Case

A petition having been presented and filed, signed by August Borble & 18 others asking for the location of a certain road as follows to wit: - Beginning at the N.E. cor of Sec. 1-14-19, thence due west about 330 rods to intersect Road running past Pleasant Hill School house. Board decided to view same on Dec. 20, 1904, to meet at the place of beginning
