And it is hereby certified and recited that all acts
conditions and things required to be done precedent to and
in the issuing of this bond have been properly done
happened and been performed in regular and due form,
and time as required by law; and that the indebtedness
refunded into this bond was and is a valid, subsisting and bind-
ing obligation of the said County; and that the total indebtedness
of the said County including this bond, does not exceed
any Constitutional or Statutory Limitations.
