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Bridge Contract

On motion of Mr Brune the Mo. Valley Bridge and Iron Co was awarded the Contract to erect a One Hundred Thirty Eight foot span (The same being the North Span of the Kansas River Bridge at Lawrence Kansas) across the Wakarusa river at the Meade Crossing, on 4 rivet tubes according to the direction of the County Surveyor, at actual cost plus 12%. Also driving the piling for the Dyke in Grant Township Also One dyke in Wakarusa Township to protect the Collins ditch - at actual cost plus 12%
