

The present jail, it is necessary to employ and pay a turnkey or guard from Forty (\$40.00) to Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars per month.

Second, on account of the dilapidated condition of the building, it requires at a large expense, an extra amount of fuel to heat said jail.

Third, on account of the defective plumbing in the present jail being insanitary, there is a constant expense to keep same in condition to be habitable.

Fourth, on account of the distance from the old jail to the Court house, it is and will be exceedingly very inconvenient and expensive in the taking of prisoners from the jail to the Court house for preliminary hearings, trials, etc.

Fifth, We believe that the Citizens of Douglas County want and desire that a new jail be erected at the earliest possible date.

Sixth, Be it further resolved, that we request that our State Senator and Representatives use their best efforts in obtaining the passage of an enabling Act. at the coming session of the State Legislature, authorizing Douglas County to construct a jail at a cost not to exceed \$30,000.00 Thirty Thousand Dollars by authorizing the Board of County Commissioners to levy tax for the years 1905 and 1906 for that purpose.

Be it further resolved that a copy of the above and foregoing resolution be presented to the Honorable U. S. Griffin State Senator and the Hon. W. R. Stubbs and The Hon. J. L. Brady Representatives
