

Meeting of County Assessors, March 6, 1908.

The assessors of Douglas County, Kansas, met to fix basis of valuations for Douglas County. There were present H. B. Asher, Lawrence; C. E. Engle, Mahanoma Township; A. S. Hood, Grant Township; H. E. Stone, Leecompton Township; H. F. Brass, Kanawaka Township; H. B. Banning, Clinton Township; J. A. Anderson, Marion Township; C. E. Percy, Willow Springs Township; J. E. Perry, Palmyra Township; E. Gerstenberger, Eudora Township.

H. E. Stone of Leecompton Township was elected chairman, and A. S. Hood of Grant Township was elected Secretary.

A motion carried to assess all property at its full value, take away the two hundred dollars exemption, then divide by four.
