August Boehle
Road case.

In the matter of road as petitioned for by August Boehle and Eighteen others, being recorded on page 42 vol. H. Commissioners' record, the Board adopted the report of the viewers. The viewers reported the petition granted. The petition is as follows: vacate a road in Douglas County, Kansas, beginning at South East corner of Sec. 1, T. 14, R. 19, thence due West about three hundred thirty rods to intersect road running past Pleasant Grove school house. - The Board declared said road vacated. August Boehle has paid all expense in publishing notice and viewing said road, amounting to eighteen ¹⁰⁰/₁₀₀ dollars.

Wm. Landon
Road case.

In the matter of road as petitioned for by Wm. Landon and fifteen others, being recorded on page 43, vol. H., Commissioners record, the Board adopted the report of the viewers, which report is: We recommend the location of a road, forty feet in width, beginning at a point sixty-three feet west of the South West corner of Sec. 11, T. 14, R. 20, thence N. 32° 13' E. 119 ft., thence N. on line 600 ft., thence North 7° 6' East five hundred ft., thence West seventy nine feet to a point on section line, thence North on section line to the North West corner of Sec. 11, T. 14, R. 20; - The Board declared above said road located and established as a public highway. There were no damages asked for in the laying of said road.

Bills.

Bills against the county were allowed.
