Jetty in
Grant
Township.

In matter of "jetty" in Grant Township, the Board agreed to construct the frame work for a jetty ready for filling, Grant Township to fill the same. The jetty is to project into the river forty feet from the bank. The piles on either ^{side} are to be driven five feet apart and the sides are to be ten feet apart. The jetty to be rodded and made ready for filling by the county. Grant Township to arrange with the land owners for the right of way for the machinery to be conveyed to the river bank.
