Palm, trustee, and the Board being fully advised, in the matter find that the taxes of fifty three $\frac{1}{100}$ dollars levied on certain notes held by said trustee, was levied upon notes that were given by Blenda Reynolds and William L. Palm and represent sums of money advanced from time to time from said estate to said children and were held simply as receipts for said money advanced. Wherefore it is considered, ordered and adjudged that said tax is illegal, and that said notes are not liable to taxation, and the County Treasurer is hereby ordered to cancel the same.

In the matter of taxes in re Emily P. D. Woodward. This matter came on to be heard upon the petition of Emily P. D. Woodward and affidavit of Chester Woodward her agent and relates to assessments for 1903-~~2~~, 1904, and the Board, being fully advised in the matter, finds that for the years 1903 & 1904 there were assessed certain notes and mortgages that had been paid or assigned prior to said years, and that the tax on the same was six hundred thirty nine $\frac{37}{100}$ dollars (\$639.57). Wherefore it is considered, ordered and adjudged that six hundred thirty nine $\frac{37}{100}$ dollars of said taxes for said years were illegally & improperly assessed as follows: for 1903, two hundred forty two $\frac{62}{100}$ dollars; and for 1904, three hundred ninety seven $\frac{25}{100}$ dollars; and the county treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to receive in payment of said taxes for 1903 & 1904 the sum of three thousand three hundred fifty six $\frac{62}{100}$ dollars.
