Bills were allowed as per Allowance Record.

A Petition having been filed May 3, 1905, signed by Wm. F. Osborn and twenty-two (22) others, was presented to the Board of County Commissioners, which petition asked for the Location & Vacation of certain roads as follows: Locate, Begin at North East corner of Sec. 33, T. 14, R. 20, running West to the quarter Section line of said Section, 33, said road not to exceed fifty feet in width. Vacate, the road running North West & South East through the North East quarter of said section 33, T. 14, R. 20. Whereupon the Board of County Commissioners set June 12, 1905, to view said roads and give all parties a hearing, and will meet with the county Surveyor at the place of beginning of new road.
