May 9, 1905. Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, met in adjourned regular session. All members present; Geo. H. Brune, J. C. Walton, A. C. Walter and County Clerk.

The bill of Overton Manufacturing and Engineering Company for thirty-two <sup>00</sup>/<sub>100</sub> dollars signed by Geo. H. Savage was rejected.

In the matter of "Omitted Tax" of Wm. T. Sinclair, the Board being fully advised that said tax was based upon notes & Mortgages that were assigned and not subject to tax, it is considered, ordered and adjudged that said tax is illegal, and the County Treasurer is hereby ordered to cancel the same.

In the matter of the U. P. R. R. Co. building a temporary pile approach to the North end of the Lawrence <sup>Kansas River</sup> bridge across the washout caused by the flood of 1903, a settlement being made June 8, 1904, by former Board for five thousand dollars with interest at 4 per cent from June 8, 1904, until paid; total to date being five thousand one hundred Seventy Eight <sup>25</sup>/<sub>100</sub> dollars. On motion the Board appropriated the last named amount above, for the payment of said debt, and instructed the County Clerk to draw warrant for that amount payable to the Treasurer of U. P. R. R. Co.
