The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, met in adjourned Special Session. Geo. H. Brune, J. C. Halton, A. C. Hatter and the County Clerk were present.

In the Matter of Omitted Personal Property Tax of John L. Kilworth. The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, having under consideration the matter of taxation of John L. Kilworth on personal property alleged to have been omitted from the tax rolls for the years 1898 to 1904 both inclusive, upon sworn testimony to the Board, it appears to the satisfaction of the Board that for the said several years the said John L. Kilworth listed with the assessor of the City of Lawrence all personal property owned by him subject to taxation upon the first day of March of said several years, and as to the mortgages appearing upon the omitted property roll in the office of the Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas, charged against the said John L. Kilworth the Board of Commissioners, upon the evidence furnished, finds that said Kilworth is not personally liable to pay the taxes thereon or any part thereof, but that as to certain of said Mortgages, per list attached, to-wit:----- the said John L. Kilworth agreed to pay the taxes 1902, 1903 & 1904 last past, amounting in all to the sum of sixty⁰⁰/₁₀₀ dollars, less Sheriff's fees taxed at eleven⁰⁰/₁₀₀ dollars. It is therefore ordered by the Board that upon the payment of said amount by said Kilworth to the treasurer of said county of Douglas, that all taxes now appearing upon the omitted property tax roll charged to said John L. Kilworth be fully discharged.

And it further appearing that the said John L. Kilworth did on the 8th day of August pay to the sheriff of Douglas County upon a tax warrant issued for said taxes the sum of two thousand one hundred⁰⁰/₁₀₀ dollars, which said payment was made by the said Kilworth under protest, and which said sum of money has since said date been by the then sheriff of Douglas County paid over to John H. Games as treasurer of said County.

It is therefore ordered by the Board that the said sum of two thousand one hundred⁰⁰/₁₀₀ dollars be repaid to said Kilworth by the treasurer of said County upon presentation of a copy of this order which shall be his voucher therefor.
