The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned Special session. Geo. H. Brune, J. C. Hutton, A. C. Hutton, and County Clerk were present. The following petition was presented to the Board.

Lawrence, Kansas, May 19, 1905.

To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners, Douglas County, Kansas:  
Gentlemen:

The Uncle Sam Oil & Refinery Company of Cherryvale, Kansas, hereby respectfully petitions your honorable body, to grant the said company the right to lay a pipe line, not to exceed six inches in diameter, along the edge of one of the highways of said county from the West line of said county East to nearly South of Lawrence, thence East to East line of Douglas County, and the right to lay the said pipe line over any of the county bridges of said county, forming part of the said highway to be selected, subject to the following conditions, to wit:

1<sup>st</sup>. That before any start is made, or the laying of the said pipe line is begun, that the said Uncle Sam Company shall secure the consent of the Board of Highway Commissioners of each municipal township of this county over whose highways the said pipe line will pass, and also the consent of the abutting land owners.

2<sup>nd</sup>. To bury the said pipe line not less than one foot deep where it crosses intersecting crossroads.

3<sup>rd</sup>. To file in the office of the County Clerk of said Douglas County sectional township maps of each township of said County showing the highways and the bridges of such, over which the said pipe line will pass, before the laying of such pipe line is begun.

4<sup>th</sup>. The said pipe line shall be placed at one side of the said highway close to the bordering hedge or fence of said highway, and shall be completed within one year from the date hereof.

### Order of Board.
