

line of said county is hereby granted to the said Uncle Sam Refinery Company as above set forth, and subject to the following conditions: That the said petition is hereby made part of and the conditions proceeding this order.

1st. That before laying any pipe line along any of the highways or over the bridges of said county, that the said Refinery Company shall file in the office of the County Clerk of said county a plat of the townships its pipe line will pass through, with the highways along which said pipe line will be laid and the bridges over which it will cross.

2nd. That said pipe line shall be laid on the outside of all bridges crossed by the same.

3rd. That it shall secure the consent of the owners of the land along the highway on which said pipe line is laid before work is commenced.

4th. That it shall secure the consent of the Board of Highway Commissioners of the townships of this county having control of the highways its pipe line will be laid along.

5th. That the said pipe line shall be buried, at least one foot in depth, whenever it may cross an intersecting or cross highway, the depth at said intersections to be fixed by the Board of Highway Commissioners, and that the laying of said pipe line shall be completed within one year of the date hereof.

6th. That said company in consideration of the use of the bridges and the right to use said bridges along the line of said pipeline, hereby agrees to furnish oil for fuel for the court house in Lawrence, in said county & state, at manufacturing prices, said oil to be delivered at the nearest distributing point of said company to the city of Lawrence, if said Douglas County desires to use oil for fuel purposes.

7th. That the said Uncle Sam Oil & Refinery Company shall pay all damages it may cause to the property of this county, or the persons and property along the route of its said pipe-line, which shall be placed close to the boundary hedge or fence along one side of the highway it shall use, whenever possible to do so.
