The following petition was presented to the Board.

To the honorable board of county commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas.
Gentlemen, the tax for 1904 on lot 5, Alder's Addition in the City of Lawrence was sixty three dollars, which amount I consider entirely too much, considering condition of improvements on said lot on March 1, 1904, the house merely having the foundation and rough frame at that date. I therefore ask that your honorable body reduce my tax from sixty dollars to twenty one dollars for the year 1904.

May 27, 1905. The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, met in adjourned session. Gus. H. Brune, J. C. Halton, A. C. Walter and the county clerk, present.

By order of the Board Fred Lee & Chester Hunter were released from the County Jail.

In the matter of road as petitioned for by A. V. Strong and twenty five others, being recorded on page 73, Vol. H., Commissioners' Record, the Board accepted the recommendations of the viewers. The Field notes of the action are as follows: Location—Begin. at N.E. cor. of S.E. of 31-13-18, thence N. $12\frac{1}{2}$ rods, thence in a southeasterly direction to a point on E. line of Sec. 31 which is 16 rods S. of begin, th. N. 16 rods to beginning, containing 100 sq. rods. Also, Notes of center line of road dedicated: Begin on E. line of 31-13-18 at a point 676 ft. S. of N.E. cor. of S.E. of 31-13-18, thence N. 725 ft. to center of Lawrence and Cambridge road. Notes of location: Beginning on E. line of 31-13-18, 49 ft. S. of N.E. cor. of S.E. of 31-13-18, thence S. 50° N. 960 ft. All in S.E. of 31-13-18. The Board accepted the recommendation of viewers in paying twenty five dollars for the above described three cornered piece. The Board declared the above road located and established as a public highway forty feet wide.

Board adjourned to meet June 2, 1905.
