

June 13, 1905. The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session.

Bills were allowed as per Allowance Record.

On motion the Board ordered, under the advice of the County Attorney, that the assessment on the "Omitted Tax Rolls" against Mrs. M. S. Green for the years 1898 to 1904, inclusive, be cancelled, said taxes appearing on pages 42 & 55 of said roll, and the sheriff be directed to return the tax warrants now in his hands against said Mrs. Green and the same be cancelled.

In the matter of "Omitted Tax" of 1903, against Prof. F. W. Blackmar, guardian, the Board ordered that he be allowed to pay seventy three ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ dollars and the sheriff fees & other costs, and that the treasurer be instructed to cancel the balance of said tax.

Luther N. Lewis came before the Board of Equalization with a sworn statement regarding his personal property of 1905. On motion Board changed his assessment of Mortgages from twenty eight thousand to twenty thousand, and his Lumber yard from eighty six hundred to seventy four hundred.

Taxes on Lot "J", Grove St., Baldwin, for the years 1902 & 1903 were cancelled, that lot belonging at that time to the M. E. Church.
