Osborn Road. Before the Board appeared people from Baldwin who presented the subject of the Osborn Road case pro & con. The Board decided to defer final action until 1st Monday in Aug. 1905.

B. E. Hoar Road. A petition signed by B. E. Hoar & 20 others was presented to the Board, which petition asked for a road and vacation as follows: Beginning at a point about 320 feet East of the Greenwood Valley School House grounds and on the south section line of 36-11-17, going East to the next half section corner, thence North on the half section line to where the present road meets the said line, and that the present road between these two points be vacated as soon as the new one is opened and made passable. The Board of County Commissioners agreed to meet Aug. 16, 1905, at place of Beginning to view said road and give all interested parties a hearing.
