The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned session with Geo. H. Brune, J. C. Mallon, A. C. Matter and the County Clerk present.

A petition signed by J. B. Raber ³⁸ & 48 others was presented to the Board, praying for the vacation and relocation of certain roads as follows:— Vacate— Begin 20 ch. E. of the center $\frac{1}{4}$ corner in the center of Sec. 16-13-18, Douglas Co., thence vary $9^{\circ} 15' E. \& 1.75^{\circ}$ ch., S. 9.86° ch., S. $72^{\circ} E. 12.80^{\circ}$ ch., S. $53^{\circ} E. 7.33^{\circ}$ ch. to a point 30 ft. N. of E. line of Sec. 16, 21 $\frac{33}{100}$ ch. N. of S.E. corner of said Sec. 16. Relocate— Begin in the present road 30 ft. N. of N.E. cor. of S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 16-13-18, thence south near as practicable so roads more or less to intersect the present N. $\frac{3}{4}$ S. road on E. line of S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 16-13-18. The Board set Aug. 31, 1905 as date to view above mentioned roads, and give all parties a hearing.

A petition signed by Geo. F. Derby and 29 others was presented to the Board, said petition praying for the location of road as follows:— Begin about 20 rods N. of S.W. cor. of N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 16-13-19, thence bearing to the E. and N. around the right bank of Wakarusa Creek, coming back to the section line N. of the creek a proper distance from the bank of the creek for a good road. The former road at this place has been washed away. The Board agreed to meet with County Surveyor at place of beginning, on Aug. 30, 1905, to view said road and give all parties a proper hearing.
