

Aug. 7, 1905 Board of County Commissioners met in regular session with Geo. H. Brune, J. C. Walton, A. C. Walter & County Clerk present.

Bills were allowed as per Allowance Record.

The Board took final action on the Osborn Road as recorded on page 90 of this book, and on motion Board rejected the petition.

On motion the Board instructed the County treasurer to accept \$17⁰⁰ for the tax of 1904 on Lot 107, Earl's Addition to the City of Lawrence, the tax on said lot being \$24⁰⁰, which was \$7⁰⁰ in excess.
