On motion the Board accepted the report of the viewers which follows: Locate, begin at point 30ft. N. of N.E. cor. of S.E. of Sec. 16-13-18, thence 86° 18' N. 47 ft., & 12° 8' E. 216 ft., S. 85° 4' E. to intersect road now established. We ^{also} recommend that the vacation asked for in the petition be not allowed.

On motion the above road was located and established as a public highway, and the clerk was authorized to so notify the Township Trustee.

^{Merchants Nat. Bank.} The Merchants National Bank of Lawrence, Kan., applied to the Board to be made a depository for Douglas County Funds. On Motion the Board agreed to grant its desire upon the filing of a bond acceptable to the County Board.
