The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, met in adjourned session. Geo. H. Brune, J. C. Halton & County Clerk present.

A petition signed by O. L. Cox and 41 others was presented to the Board praying the vacation and location of certain roads as follows:—
Locate:— That portion of the Lawrence & Eudora Road running North & South in Sec. 33, T. 12 - R. 20. Locate:— A road in said Section beginning about 30 yds. West of the present road running North & South in said Sec. 33, thence South to the North line of Sec. 4 - T. 13 - R. 20. The Board set Dec. 18, 1905, to view said road and give all parties a hearing.

Begin at a point on Sec. line 569 ft. S. of N.E. cor. of Sec 24-13-19, thence S. $35^{\circ}37'$ E. 255 ft., S. $66^{\circ}21'$ W. 184 ft., North on line 259 ft. to begin. All in the N.W. of Sec. 19 - T. 13 - R. 20, and containing $\frac{769}{1000}$ more or less.

Above dedication was signed by Maude M. Trovillo.

Also: Begin at a point on the sec. line 342 ft. South of N.E. cor. of Sec. 24 - T. 13 - R. 19, thence S. $33^{\circ}54'$ W. 181 ft., S. $35^{\circ}37'$ E. 173 $\frac{5}{8}$ ft., N. on line 291 ft. to beginning. All in the N.E. of Sec. 24 - T. 13 - R. 19, and containing $\frac{268}{1000}$ more or less.
