Lawrence; that said lots are assessed at an aggregate of \$285⁰⁰ which I consider an unjust assessment; that the taxes of 1904 & 1905 are yet unpaid, and as I desire to pay the same, I respectfully ask that I be allowed to do so upon the basis of \$200⁰⁰ valuation.
