Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned session, with Gus H. Brune, J. C. Walton, A. C. Walter & the County Clerk present.

On motion the Board remitted the fine of Mrs. Jessie White and released her from jail, she having served the term of her sentence and paid the costs and also filed an affidavit that she would not engage in the sale of intoxicating liquors or allow them to be sold on premises occupied by her.
