IN THE MASTER OF THE CLAIM OF WILLIAM C. BIGGER.

Whereas, at the January meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas county, Kansas for the year of 1906, an agreement was entered into with W. C. Bigger who at that time had a claim pending before said Board for the refunding of certain taxes which he had paid under protest, and,

Whereas, the only memorandum of said agreement was made upon said petition and whereas, said original petition was lost and a substituted petition filed and,

Whereas, the minutes of said meeting fail to show said agreement and whereas, it was agreed at said time, between said Board of County Commissioners and said William C. Bigger that as there was at that time pending in the Courts the claim of Hannah Lane against the Board of County Commissioners, which claim was in all respects identical with the claim of said W. C. Bigger except as to amount, and which claim it was understood by said Board and said W. C. Big ger would be appealed to the Supreme Court of the State of Kansas for final adjudication and determinationand,

Whereas, it was thereupon agreed, to avoid further litigation, that the said claim of William C. Bigger should abide the decision of the claim of Hannah Lane and that if the Supreme Court of the State of gansas decided that the Board of County Commissioners should refund to said Hannah Lane the money that she had paid under protest, that the said Board of County Commissioners would then refund the taxes paid by said William C. Bigger under protest, and as prayed for in his petition.

Now, therefore, the clerk of said Board is hereby directed to correct the minutes of the meeting of January, 1906 by recording the above as the minutes of said meeting in regard to the tax matter of William C. Bigger.
