In the matter Henry Davis Road case, the Board accepted the report of the viewers which is as follows:— We recommend that the N² of the road as petitioned for be laid forty feet wide, the S² being already a road. The field notes are Begin 5 ft. W. of $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. cor. on W. line of Sec. 35-12-17, thence N. parallel with to Sec. line 1300 ft., E. 20 ft., N. $1^{\circ} 42'$ N. and following a line 15 ft. East and parallel to a stone wall 737 ft., N. $19^{\circ} 30'$ E. 247 ft., N. $5^{\circ} 30'$ N. 373 ft. to intersect road on North line of Sec. 35-12-17. Magnetic variation $8^{\circ} 40'$ E.

Damages were claimed as follows: C. L. Worthington 25° , J. Long 25° . Said Worthington was awarded Twenty-five dollars.

On Motion the above road was declared a public highway, & the Clerk was instructed to so notify the trustee of Kawakee Township. The Chairman & Clerk of the Board were authorized to issue the following amounts in County Warrants:— C. L. Worthington 25° as damages, Henry Davis & Fred Davis each 15° as chairmen.
