

Feb. 5, 1906. The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session. J. C. Walton, A. C. Walter, Geo. H. Brune & County Clerk were present.

Bills Bills against the county were examined and allowed as per allowance Record.

Road of J. Parnell The Official Bond of A. J. Parnell as Poor Commissioner was approved by the County Board.

Road J. F. Hammond A petition signed by J. F. Hammond & twenty others was presented to the Board, asking for the location of a road described as follows: Begin at S.E. cor. of S.E. 1/4 of 23-14-19, thence N. one half mile. Said road to be thirty feet wide. The Board set March 19th, 1906, to view said road and give all parties a hearing.

Road A. Hill A petition signed by C. A. Hill and 46 others was presented to the Board, praying for the location of a road described as follows: Begin at or near the Dykeman Bridge across the Wakarusa River, thence in a Northeastly direction to section line between Section 12 & 13, thence E. on said line to N.W. cor. of N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 13, thence in a Southeastly direction across same to Little Wakarusa Creek, thence E. across said creek to the intersection of the public road on the E. side thereof. The Board set March 21, 1906, to meet at place of beginning and view said road and give all parties a hearing.

Road Frank Vogel A petition signed by Frank Vogel & 18 others was presented to the Board, asking for the location of a road described as follows: Begin at S.W. cor. of Sec. 34-12-21, thence E. about 140 ft. roads, th. Northeast to point on 1/2 Sec. line 40 rods N. of S.E. cor. of S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 34, th. N. 40 rods to N.W. cor. of S.W. 1/4 of S.E. 1/4 of said Sec. 34, th. E. 40 or 80 rods where it connects with a common consent road, th. N. on said road to connect with public road running parallel with A.T. & S.F. R.R. A donation of land for said road will be made by Frank Vogel upon condition that the road running parallel with the A.T. & S.F. R.R. through the S.W. 1/4 of said Sec. 34 be vacated. The Board set March 20, 1906 to meet at beginning and view said road and give all parties a hearing.

Board adjourned to meet Feb. 6, 1906.
