Cummings
Road.

A petition signed by J. P. Cummings & 20 others was presented to the Board of County Commissioners praying for the Location of a road described as follows:

"Begin at the center corner of Sec. 12-12-18, thence North on the $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. line as far as a practical highway can be made, thence West & North to the center of Oakley Bridge, thence North & West to the North line of Sec. 12-12-18, thence West to the N.W. corner of the Sec. 12-12-18." Whereupon the commissioners set Dec., 14, 1906, as the date to meet with the county surveyor at the place of beginning to view said proposed road, and give all parties a hearing.

Constable
