

Nov. 12, 1906. The Board of County Commissioners met in regular adjourned session. J. C. Wallon, A. C. Waller, Gus H. Brune and the County Clerk were present.

Bills Claims against the county were examined and allowed as per allowance record.

Kate Henry Road. In the matter of Kate Henry road as petitioned for on Aug. 11, 1906, and viewed Sept. 14, 1906, The Board accepted the report of the viewers. The viewers recommended that the road be granted as located & surveyed, and that it be established and opened forty feet wide. The Field Notes are: - *Locate* Begin 552 ft. West of N.E. corner of the tract half of the N.W. of Sec. 33 - T. 11 - R. 18., thence south $15^{\circ} 18' 41$. 325 feet, S. $21^{\circ} 20'$ N. 88 ft., S. $54^{\circ} 40'$ W. 341 ft., S. 35° W. 187 ft., S. $52^{\circ} 45'$ W. 82 ft., S. 65° W. 133 ft., S. $71^{\circ} 30'$ W. 170 ft., to intersect County road #422. *Also locate:* All of County road #422 included between the ends of the above described road. No damages were asked. On motion the Board declared the above road located and established as a public highway and instructed the clerk to so notify the trustee of Lecompton Township of the action.
