Cancelled.

Whereas; On the 8th day of December, 1906, the said C. A. Richards filed his answer setting forth a statement that he lays no claim to said office,

Therefore it is ordered, adjudged & decreed that the said Nelson Threlkeld be and he is hereby declared the holder of said office of Township Clerk for the coming term, and further proceedings are hereby stayed.
