

Dec. 12, 1906. The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session. J. C. Walton, A. C. Walter, Gus H. Brune and the county clerk were present.

Bills. The Board examined claims against the county and allowed as per Allowance Record.

Bonds. The Board approved the Bonds of T. J. Anderson, Justice of the Peace elect of Beacompton Township; Chas. Gabriel, Trustee elect of Eudora Township; W. H. Humphrey, Treasurer elect of Clinton Township; Leo H. Schowengerdt, Constable elect of Grant Township; and T. D. Whedon, Justice of the Peace elect in Wakarusa Twp.

Petitions Granted. Upon petition of Wm. T. Sinclair, the Board instructed the County Treasurer to allow said Sinclair to redeem from the sale of 1906 for \$36⁷⁵, the orig. amount of tax, the following under certificate #5:— Begin 10¹/₂ ch. N. of N.E. cor. of S.E. 4, Th. N. 17³/₁₀₀ ch. S. 60 N. 2⁷⁵/₁₀₀ ch. S. 3⁷⁵/₁₀₀ ch. E. 19 ch. N. 5 ch. to begin. in 36-12-19. Also: That said Wm. T. Sinclair be allowed to redeem from the sale of 1905 for \$25⁰⁰ (certificate #189) and Tax of 1905 endorsed on said sale Sept. 4, 1906 for \$27⁰⁰, amounting to the sum of \$53¹⁰ on the following:— The N¹/₂ of the following:— Begin 660 ft. N. 2¹/₂ 330 ft. E. of S.W. cor. of N.W. 36-13-20, Th. E. 1011 ft. to center of Vermont St. in Babcock's enlarged Add., N. 640 ft. to center of cross st. in said Add., N. 700 ft. to land owned by P. Albach, S. 132 ft. to S.E. cor. of said Albach's land, N. 311 ft. to land formerly owned by N. A. Osborn, S. to begin. Except part lying E. of E. line of Tenn. St. & also added to Mary E. Croff & E. Sale Cancelled. The sale of 1896 of the following property: Begin at N.W. cor. of N.E. 4 of Sec. 36-12-19, Th. E. on N. boundary line of said quarter Sec. 1513 ft., S. 24 ft., N. 1513 ft., N. 24 ft. to begin, under certificate #321 for \$9⁷³ upon which sale the taxes for 1896, amounting to \$9⁶¹, and taxes of 1897, amounting to \$10²⁶, were charged, having been shown to the Board as illegal, the Board instructed the County Treasurer & County Clerk to mark said sale as "Illegal, Cancelled by order of the Board of Commissioners, Dec. 12, 1906."

Tax Cancelled. It being shown to the Board that an error had been made in the assessment of the personal property of Mrs. M. Hay, Lawrence, Kan., and she having paid the first half of the tax on said erroneous assessment, the Board allowed a bill of \$10³⁵ in her favor and instructed the County Treasurer to cancel the last half of said Mrs. M. Hay's personal tax.

Omitted Tax Cancelled. It being shown to the Board that the mortgages upon which the "Omitted tax" of W. W. Jenkins for the years 1903 & 1904 were computed were included in his assessments for those years, the Board ordered the cancellation of said "Omitted taxes" against said W. W. Jenkins for said years 1903 & 1904.

Tax Cancelled. On account of excessive assessment, the Board cancelled \$10⁰⁰ of the 1906 tax against the following property on High St., Baldwin, Kan.:— Begin at point 40 ft. E. of S.W. cor. of Lot 3, Th. E. 20 ft., N. 104 ft., E. 12 ft., N. 36 ft., N. 12 ft., S. 24 ft., N. 20 ft., S. 116 ft. to begin.
