Dr. Clark having filed a paper stating that he wished to resign as county health officer, the Board accepted his resignation.

W. H. Banning, trustee of Clinton Township, J. E. Gerstenberger, trustee of Eudora Township, made their annual reports, which reports were approved by the Board.

In the matter of James K. Means road as petitioned for Oct. 10, 1906, Viewed Nov. 16, 1906, the Board accepted the report of the viewers. The viewers recommended that the road be granted, as located & surveyed and that it be established and opened forty feet wide. Also, that the vacation asked for be granted. Also, that H. C. Bigger be allowed $\frac{75}{100}$ damages. The field notes are:- Begin 260 ft. West $\frac{1}{2}$ 20 ft. South of a point supposed to be the S.E. cor. of N.W. of Sec. 2-12-19. Thence N. 9° 00' ft., N. 20 ft., N. 1444 ft. to the S.W. cor. of the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 2-12-19. Locate:- Begin at N.E. cor. of N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 2-12-19, th. due south to the S.E. cor. of D.N. $\frac{1}{4}$ of N.W. of Sec. 11-12-19. On motion the Board declared the above road established as a public highway, and instructed the clerk to so notify the trustees of Mahaska & Grant Townships. Also, Chairman Clerk to issue warrant to H. C. Bigger for $\frac{75}{100}$.

In the matter of J. D. Melcher road as petitioned for April 7, 1906, Viewed May 10, 1906, the Board accepted the viewers' report. The viewers recommended that the road be located according to the field notes of surveyor, and that it be established and opened forty feet wide. They also recommended the following damages:- D. B. Bond, $\frac{20}{100}$; J. D. Melcher, $\frac{20}{100}$; August Hock, $\frac{5}{100}$; G. H. Melcher, $\frac{15}{100}$. The field notes are:- Begin at N.E. cor. of Sec. 26-14-18, th. S. 16° 00' ft. $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. on W. side of said Sec. 26-14-18, with 40 ft. On Motion the Board declared the above road established as a public highway & instructed the Clerk to so notify the trustee of Marion Township. The chairman Clerk was instructed to issue warrants as follows:- D. B. Bond, $\frac{20}{100}$; J. D. Melcher, $\frac{20}{100}$; August Hock, $\frac{5}{100}$; G. H. Melcher, $\frac{15}{100}$.

In the matter of A. L. Williams road as petitioned for May 16, 1906, Viewed June 12, 1906, the Board accepted the viewers' report. The viewers recommended that the road be located according to the field notes of the surveyor, and that it be established and opened forty feet wide. They also recommended that the vacation asked for be granted. The field notes are:- Locate:- Begin at S.E. cor. of N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of N.W. of Sec. 10-1-19-R. 19, thence N. 73 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft., N. 45° N. 200 ft., N. 10° N. 112 ft., N. 7° E. 138 ft. Locate:- Begin at S.E. cor. of the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N.W. of Sec. 10-1-19-R. 19, thence N. 315 ft., N. 42° 10' N. 205 ft. On Motion the Board declared the above roads, the one established as a public highway, the other vacated, and instructed the clerk to so notify the trustee of Willow Springs Township.

In the matter of C. A. Hill road as petitioned for Feb. 5, 1906, Viewed March 21, 1906, the Board accepted the viewers' report. The viewers recommended that the road be located according to the field notes of the surveyor, and that it be established & opened forty feet wide. The field notes are:- Begin at the N.E. cor. of the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 13- T. 13 - R. 20; L. N. 167 ft.; S. 45° 5' N. 265 ft.; S. 30° 15' N. 190 ft. to intersect public road. Then begin at the N.E. cor. of N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of N.W. of Sec. 13- T. 13 - R. 20; thence E. 80 ft.; S. 39° E. 1175 ft.; S. 86° E. 1735 ft.; N. 44° E. 143 ft.; N. 11° E. 200 ft.; N. 450 ft. to intersect public road. On motion the Board declared the above road established as a public highway & instructed the clerk to so notify the trustee of Eudora Township. Viewers recommended that Mrs. X. Ott be allowed $\frac{50}{100}$ damage, and the Board authorized the chairman and Clerk to issue a warrant to the amount of $\frac{50}{100}$ in favor of X. Ott.
