

Jan. 16, 1907. The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session. A.C. Walter, Gus H. Brune, J.C. Walton & the County Clerk were present.

Bills. Claims against the county were examined and allowed as per allowance record.

Bonds. The Board approved the official bond of A. Hoffsommer, Justice of the Peace of Kanwaka Township.

County Printing. The Board gave the County Printing for the coming year to The Gazette.

Water Closet. The putting in of water closet in Ladies Toilet room on first floor of Court house was given to F. Rahskoff, his bid being \$42.00.

Poor Commissioner. The Board elected A. J. Parrell to succeed himself as Poor Commissioner for Douglas County for the coming year.

Tax Cancelled. The Board cancelled the personal tax of M. J. Young (Law.) for the year 1906, it being shown to the Board that it was unjust.

Warrant Cancelled. Warrant #9530 was cancelled by the Board, it being a duplicate of Warrant #8814.

The Board estimated the 1906 election expenses, and ordered the clerk to instruct the County Treasurer to charge the amounts to the several funds in his office as follows:-
