Cor. of Sec. 12-13-20, thence West, on the South side and abutting the Section line between Sections 1 & 12, 80 Rods, thence on the East side of the quarter of a quarter sec. line between the N.E.^{1/4} of N.E.^{1/4} & the N.W.^{1/4} and the S.E.^{1/4} & the S.W.^{1/4} of N.E.^{1/4} of Sec. 12, terminating at a point 80 Rods West & 160 Rods South from point of beginning. — There-upon the Board agreed to meet with the County Surveyor at the "Place of Beginning" on Mar. 21, 1907, to view said proposed road and give all parties a proper hearing.
