

Apr. 3, 1907. The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in adjourned regular session. A. C. Walter, Geo. H. Brune, J. C. Walter & the County Clerk were present.

Bills Claims against the county were examined and allowed as per Allowance Record.

Health Officer. The Board appointed Dr. John C. Rudolph to the position of Health Officer for Douglas County.

Garrett Road. A petition signed by J. A. Garrett and 22 others was presented to the Board of County Commissioners praying for the location of a road described as follows:— Begin at the center of Sec. 15-13-20, thence West one & half miles, whereupon the Board set April 27th, 1907, as the day upon which the Board would meet with the county surveyor at the place of beginning and view said proposed road and give all parties a proper hearing.

Gudd Road. A petition signed by G. Gudd & 23 others was presented to the Board of County Commissioners praying for the location of a road described as follows:— Begin at the N.E. cor. of the S.E. of Sec. 18-15-20, thence North to the R.R. π -of-w, th. N.E. along said R.R. π -of-w to the South line of Sec. 8-15-20, th. East to the S.E. corner of the S.W. of Sec. 8-15-20. Whereupon the Board set April 29, 1907, as the day upon which it would meet with the county surveyor at the place of beginning and view said proposed road and give to all interested parties a proper hearing.

Sanders Road. A petition signed by J. C. Sanders and 29 others was presented to the Board of County Commissioners praying for the location of a road described as follows:— Begin at center of Sec. 36-12-20, thence running East half mile to the North & South road. Whereupon the Board set April 30, 1907, as the date upon which it would meet with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning and view the said road, and give all parties a hearing.

Board adjourned to meet Apr. 6, 1907.
