Peoples State Bank The Peoples State Bank of Baldwin, Kansas, having filed a satisfactory bond, the Board approved said bond, thereby making said bank a depository for County funds.

Released from Jail. Sam Allen, a County prisoner, having worked out his fine, was ordered released from the jail by the Board, the Board having remitted his fine.

Henshaw Road. A petition signed by Nathan Henshaw and 16 others was presented to the Board praying for the location of the following described road, Begin 80 R. North and 160 R. East of S. E. cor. of Sec. 6, thence East to or near the Wakarusa river; the line may vary to the North, West of said river to find a better crossing for a bridge; thence East on the line 80 Rods North of South line of Sec. 5 until it reaches the West end of a hedge; from that point on the North side of said hedge to a fence running North about 9 rods; thence East to intercept 7th St. in the City of Eudora, Kansas. Whereupon the Board set May 16, 1907, as the date upon which to meet with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning to view said proposed road and give all parties a proper hearing.
