Omitted Tax.
Hilder S. Metcalf.

The Board passed the following resolution: Whereas in an action in the District Court of Douglas County, State of Kansas, wherein Hilder S. Metcalf was plaintiff and Elmer E. Myers as Sheriff of said County, John W. James Treasurer of said County, the Board of County Commissioners of said County of Douglas, and others were defendants, to restrain and enjoin the enforcement collection or attempt to collect certain alleged taxes of the year 1898 to 1903 inclusive upon a certain tax warrant then in the hands of said sheriff, it was by the said Court, on the 31 day of December, 1904, ordered, adjudged & decreed that said sheriff, his deputies, agents and servants, and as well all other of said defendants and their agents and servants be perpetually enjoined from collecting, enforcing, or attempting to collect or enforce said tax warrant. Therefore, Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kan., that all said taxes for the years 1898 to 1903 inclusive as entered on the book called "Omitted Personal Property Roll" as against said Hilder S. Metcalf be and the same are hereby ordered cancelled and annulled.

Bateson Released from Jail.
