Schopper
Road.

A petition signed by Joe Schopper & 54 others was presented to the Board of County Commissioners praying for a road to be viewed and located as follows:— Begin at a point where the west end of 10th St. in the City of Endora intersects Sec. 8-13-21, thence in a North West direction till said road intersects the section line between Sections 5 & 8, thence start along said section line to or near the Wakarusa River. The line may vary to the North, East of said river if necessary to find a better crossing for a bridge which is to be built over said Wakarusa River. Whereupon the Board set June 14, 1907, as the date upon which to meet with the county surveyor at the place of beginning to view said proposed road and give all parties a hearing.
