Road.

A petition signed by D.C. Stevens & 15 others was presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the location & vacation of certain roads described as follows:—Locate—Begin at a point in the Andrew Dosh Road which is 136 ft. N. & 10 ft. N. of the S.E. cor. of N. 1/2 of N. 1/2 of N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 18-14-20, thence S. 9° N. 133 ft., S. 19° N. 252 ft., S. 35° N. 218 ft. Vacate—vacate that portion of the Andrew Dosh Road between the above mentioned points. Whereupon the Board set June 18, 1907, as the date to meet with the County Surveyor at the point of beginning and view the above proposed road and give all parties a proper hearing.
