Gannon Road Final. In the matter of the John Gannon Road as petitioned for May 16, 1906. Viewed June 18-1906, the Board accepted the report of the viewers. The viewers recommended that the road be located according to the field notes of the surveyor, and that it be established and opened 25 ft. wide. The field notes are:—Reg. at & corner N. line of N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 12-13-17, th. S. 160 R. across said 1/4 section, E. 8 1/2 ft., N. 160 R., N. 8 1/2 ft. to begin. Also:—Reg. at the & corner N. line of N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 12-13-17, th. S. 160 R. across said 1/4 sec., N. 16 1/2 ft., N. 160 R., E. 16 1/2 ft. to begin. The above described land to be used as a road. On motion the Board declared the above road established as a public highway, and instructed the clerk to so notify the trustee of Hakanusa Township. The viewers also recommended that Chas. E. Sutton be allowed \$150.00 as damage, and the Board instructed its chairman and clerk to issue a warrant for that amount in said Sutton's favor.
