

defendant, John H. Kelsey, and the defendant H.C. Miller, amounts to the sum of \$20²⁰; in all the sum of \$121³⁰.

That since the default of the said defendant, William Callahan, the said John H. Kelsey endeavored to find and have arrested, and endeavored to produce the said Callahan. That on or about the day of June, 1907, he found the said Callahan in the State of Missouri, and procured his arrest, and had him returned to this county, and by the Sheriff committed to the county jail under the said sentence & judgement rendered against him for the violation of the Prohibitory Law. And that he, the said Kelsey, paid the expenses of the Sheriff in apprehending the said Callahan, and in returning him to the said jail, where the said Callahan is now confined, serving out his said sentence.

This defendant, John H. Kelsey, now comes and offers to raise the money and pay all the costs, heretofore set out, to-wit: in the sum of \$121³⁰, and prays that on the payment of such amount, he may be released from any further payment upon the judgement rendered in this action, and that said judgement may be satisfied as to him.

Comes now John H. Kelsey, by John D. A. Norton, his attorney, & also comes Thomas Harley, County Attorney of this County. And thereupon the application filed by the said John H. Kelsey, offering to pay a certain amount in the event that the said judgement should be satisfied as to him; and upon investigation and due consideration by the Board, it is hereby ordered, that upon the payment of the costs in the case of the State of Kansas vs. William Callahan, to-wit: in the sum of \$101¹⁰, & the costs in the case of the State of Kansas, on Relation of Thomas Harley, vs. William Callahan, et al., in the sum of \$20²⁰, in all the sum of \$121³⁰ by the said John H. Kelsey, that the judgement rendered in said action against the defendant, John H. Kelsey, be satisfied as to him, and the said Thomas Harley, County Attorney of this County, is hereby directed to enter satisfaction to said judgement so rendered in the District Court as to said John H. Kelsey, the same to remain in full force and effect as to said defendants, William Callahan & H.C. Miller.
