Order to
Cut Thistles

Whereas Chapter 359 of Laws of 1896 provides for the destruction of Russian & Canada thistles at such time as the Board of County Commissioners may direct upon notice published in one or more county papers for a time not less than three weeks before the time fixed upon for the destruction of said noxious weeds. It is therefore ordered by said Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that all Russian thistles & Canadian thistles be destroyed by every person and every corporation on all lands which he or it may own or occupy in Douglas County, Kansas, on or before the 6th day of September, 1907, and that every overseer of highways of every township in said county shall also at or after said date above mentioned in like manner destroy all noxious weeds either upon the highway of his road district, Railway right-of-way, or any unoccupied land therein, upon which the owner or lessee thereof shall
