1907. The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session. A.C. Walter, Gus H. Brune, J.C. Wallon and the clerk of the County were present.

Bills Claims against the county were examined & allowed as per Allowance Record.

On motion H^{on} Doms was allowed to redeem for \$10⁰⁰ & costs the following described tract:— That part lot #142 in Addition #2 in North Lawrence.

Redemption The Board agreed to allow C.C. James to redeem the following from the sale of 1904 without interest:— S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 28-12-20, also:— 16 7/100 off N. side of lot #6 in Sec. 33-12-20, also:— Lots 7 & 8 in Sec. 33-12-20.

The Board agreed to allow Mrs. Fullerton to redeem Lot 126 less 1/2 90ft. on Ky. St. in Lawrence from the sale of 1904 without interest.

A petition signed by Joe Schopper & 4 others was presented to the Board praying for the location of a road as follows:— Begin at N.W. cor. of Sec. 7-13-21, thence E. on Sec. line between sections 6 & 7 to intersect with road petitioned for by Joseph Schopper & others, and now being considered by the Board of Commissioners. Whereupon the Board set Sept. 30, 1907, as the day to meet with the co. surveyor at the place of beginning to view said proposed road and give all parties a hearing.
