Broers & 15 others was presented to the Board of County Commissioners praying for the location of a road described as follows:— Along the south line of Sec. 27— T. 12— R. 21, Douglas County, Kan., whereupon the Board agreed to meet as viewers in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning on Oct. 18, 1907, to view said proposed road, and give all parties a hearing.
