Churchbaugh Road Final In the matter of the John Churchbaugh road as petitioned for March 23, 1907, & viewed April 22, 1907, the Board of County Commissioners accepted the report of the viewers. The viewers recommended that the road be located according to the field notes of the County Surveyor, & that it be established & opened forty (40) feet in width. The Surveyor's Field Notes are:— Beginning 20 ft. West of S. & N. cor. of Sec. 6 - T. 14 - R. 20, thence North parallel to sec. line to a point 166 ft. South and 20 feet West of the 8 corner on the West side of the S. & N. of said Sec. 6 - T. 14 - R. 20, thence N. 40° E. 300 ft., N. 29° E. 200 ft., N. 1° W. 300 ft., N. 18° 38' N. 833 ft. to 1/4 Sec. corner, N. 200 ft., N. 17° 47' N. 678 ft., N. 11° 10' E. 1000 ft., N. 842 ft. to Section corner. On Motion the Board declared the above road established as a public highway, and instructed the clerk to so notify the Trustees of Palmyra & Willow Springs Townships. The viewers also recommend that C. H. Oaks be allowed \$66⁹⁵/₁₀₀ as damages & John Pardee be allowed \$100⁰⁰/₁₀₀ as damages, and the Board instructed the clerk & Chairman to issue warrants to said parties for said amounts.
