The Board passed the following:-

Whereas, On the 6th day of May, 1907, a petition was submitted to the Mayor and City Council of the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, asking that said City Council petition the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, to make a finding as to the advisability of adding the following described territory to said city, to-wit:-

Addition to City of Lawrence

Commencing 295 ft. & two (2) inches N. of the North East corner of the North West fractional quarter of Section Seven (7), Township 13, Range 20; thence South 295 feet 2 inches; thence East 295 ft. 2 inches; thence South 694 feet 10 inches; thence East to the right of way of the Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe Rail Road in the North East quarter of said section 7; thence South following said right of way to the South line of said North East quarter section; thence West to the South East corner of the South West quarter of the North West quarter of said section 7; thence North to the North East corner of the North West quarter of the North West quarter of said section 7; thence East to the place of beginning in Douglas County, Kansas.

And Whereas, A resolution was passed by the City Council on the 3rd day of June, 1907, at a regular meeting thereof, granting said request.

And Whereas, said city council has caused due notice to be published for three consecutive weeks in the Lawrence Daily Journal, a newspaper, which said newspaper is published and of general circulation in said city, that said petition would be presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, at their office in the Court-house in the city of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, on the 1st day of July, 1907,
