Road
Dedication

On motion the Board accepted the following dedication for road purposes:— Know all men by these presents that I, J. B. Cunningham, owner of the following described property, do, for the consideration of seventy five (75⁰⁰) dollars, dedicate the same to Douglas County, Kansas, to be used for a public highway:— Beginning at a point twenty feet south of the N.E. corner of the S.E. 4 of Sec. 2, Twp. 12 - Range 18, thence South one Rod, thence West one half mile, thence North one Rod, thence East one half mile to the place of beginning, and containing one acre more or less.

The Board instructed its chairman and clerk to issue a warrant in favor of J. B. Cunningham, and declared the above land a public highway.
