

Nov. 11, 1907. The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session. A. C. Walter, Gus H. Brune, J. C. Halton and the county clerk were present.

Bills Claims against the county were examined and allowed as per Allowance Record.

Trustee Report. A. A. Hicks, Trustee of Grant Township, made his annual report, which report was approved by the Board.

In the matter of the "Frang Vogle Road" as petitioned for on Feb. 5, 1906, and viewed on March 20, 1906, the Board of County Commissioners accepted the report of the viewers. The viewers recommended that the road be located according to the field notes of the County Surveyor and that it be established and opened forty feet in width, but the vacation asked for be not granted. The Surveyor's field notes are:— Begin at the center of the S.E. of Sec. 34-12-21,

Thence West 80 Rods, to $\frac{1}{8}$ cor on West line of said $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec.,

" South 562 ft.,

" South 35° 30' N. 267 ft.,

" " 46° 15' E. 243 ft.,

" " 3° N. 100 ft.,

" " 21° 10' N. 140 ft.,

" " 47° 45' N. 100 ft.,

" " 79° 41' N. 280 ft. to point on line,

" West on Section line to a point 285 ft. E. of the S.W. cor. of Sec. 34-12-21,

" South 24° 52' N. 133 ft.,

" " 66° 5' N. 100 ft.,

" " 50° N. 171 ft. to a point in the County road on the N. side of said sec. 34.

On motion the Board declared the above road established as a public highway and instructed the clerk to so notify the Trustee of Endora Township. The viewers also recommended the following damages:— Stephen Hill \$20⁰⁰, Chas. Pilla \$30⁰⁰, John Bruezen \$40⁰⁰, Frang Vogle \$80⁰⁰. Board authorized the chairman and clerk to issue warrants for said amounts in favor of said persons respectively.

Board adjourned to meet Nov. 13, 1907.
